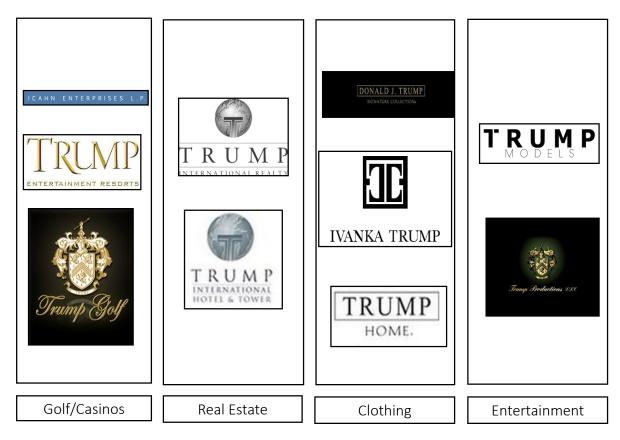
## A First Mover Leading in Innovation and Employee Equality

- Founded in 1858 on 6th avenue as a small dry goods store
- First retailer to promote a woman to an executive position in 1865
- Pioneered price quoting
- Thanksgiving Day Parade
- Restructuring program since 2015 to become more lean
- Diversity and breaking of glass ceiling: reflected in their diverse board members which consists of 12 women and 12 men

## The Presidential Campaign

- June 16, 2015: Donald Trump officially announced that he was running for president in 2016
- The presidential campaign was rife with criticism and controversy
- Proposals included the construction of a wall between Mexico and the United States after characterizing Mexicans as, criminals, drug dealers and rapists

- Remember: Macy's rich history of embracing minorities and their employment equality values

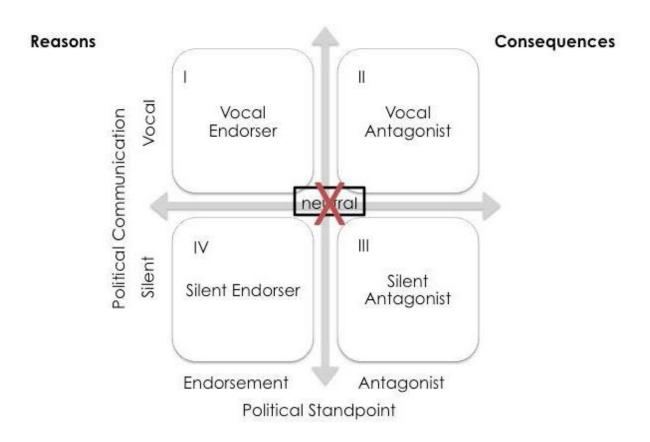

In light of statements made by Donald Trump, we have decided to discontinue our business relationship." (Terry Lundgren CEO Macy's)





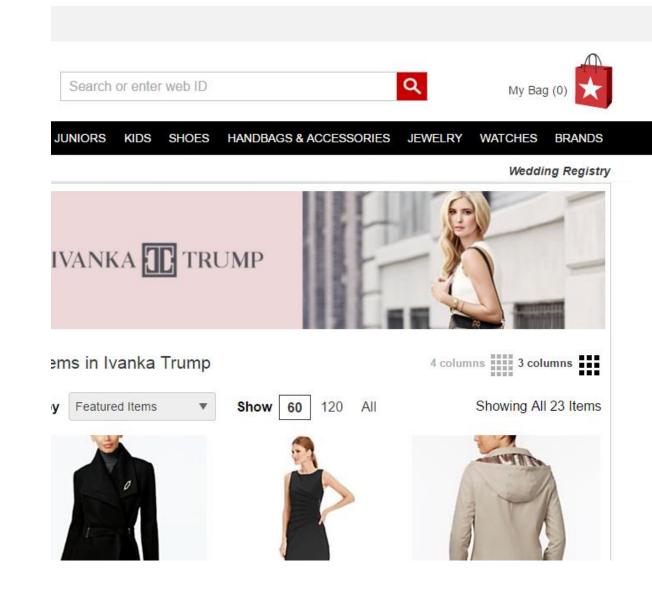

# Macy's and Ivanka Trump

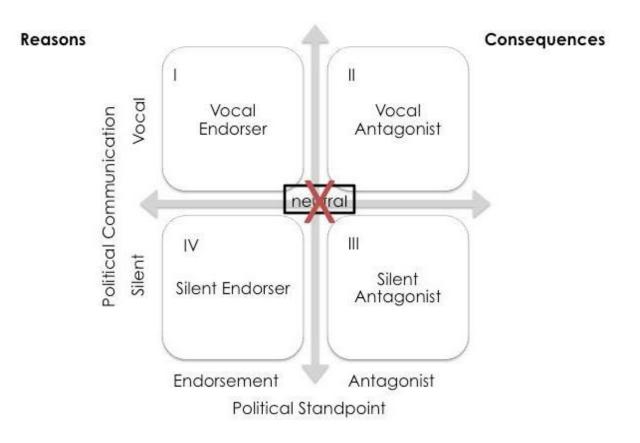
- Ivanka Trump's clothing line is a part of the Trump Organization
- Macy's are still stocking Ivanka Trump's clothing line



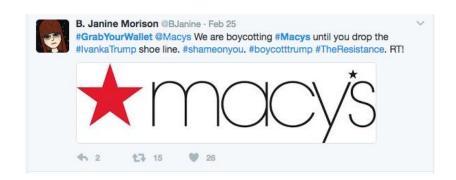
