## Abstract

The archaeological site of Heraqla in Raqqa represents a particular example of Abbasid architecture. The Caliph Harun Al Rashid (reigned 786–809) started constructing it as a commemorative monument, but because of his death in 809, it was never completed. The Directorate General of Antiquities and Museums (DGAM) excavated at the site, constructed furnaces to produce the bricks used for restorations, and, most importantly, built storehouses for the archaeological items revealed during the many decades of local, international, and joint excavations. These storehouses were inventoried once in 2003 by the author as a preliminary inventory to integrate them into a database later. Regretfully, in 2013, some 100 armed looters robbed the storehouses. The present paper is the only documentation ever completed on Heraqla's storehouses and aims to raise awareness about their importance, encourage researchers to create a database of the looted objects to identify them, and thus facilitate their recovery and restitution if they appear on the black market of antiquities, or at least prevent their circulation through sharing the database with INTERPOL and other authorities involved in fighting against illicit trafficking.

**Keywords:** Heraqla, storehouse, looted antiquities, illicit trafficking, Raqqa.

# 1. Introduction

The monument of Heraqla is situated some 7 kilometers to the west of Raqqa city (Fig.1). The main building is elevated 9 meters above the level of the surrounding plane. The site consists of a square building, 103 x 103 m, built of white limestone and bricks and surrounded by an external circular wall of 510 m diameter. An asphalt road passes through the southern part of the wall, possibly the remnant of an ancient canal excavated by Al Rashid and called the Nile Canal.

The site contains modern furnace ovens built by the Directorate General of Antiquities and Museums DGAM to produce the bricks used in the restoration of archaeological buildings in Raqqa province. There are also modern rooms constructed by the DGAM and used for storage of archaeological material that cannot be deposited in the museum of Raqqa because of the limited space in the museum's building. The archaeological expeditions that had been active in the province for more than fifteen years, used to store their small finds in the above-mentioned buildings, awaiting further research and the planned construction of the new museum in Raqqa.

In the summer of 2003, the author was appointed as director of the National Museum of Raqqa. A decision was made to compile an inventory of the archaeological items as a first step before integrating them into a digital database. The purpose of this

inventory was also to prepare for the conservation of some of the objects, as well as the transfer of important objects to be displayed in the museum.

Regretfully, unexpected changes happened on the political scene after the outbreak of the civil war in Syria. The Raqqa province, which was a completely quiet and safe place during the first two years of the war, fell in 2013, and many of the cultural heritage sites were damaged, including Heraqla. On November 3, 2013, a group of 100 armed individuals attacked the site and looted all the archaeological items. Only the large mosaics were spared because the looters could not carry them away.<sup>1</sup>

The main aim of this report is to inform the heritage community about the contents of the storehouses at Heraqla and to encourage researchers to use this information to develop further research. The goal is also to re-create, as far as possible, the inventory which in turn may be shared via the DGAM with INTERPOL, Customs services, museums, and auction houses, thus making the illicit trafficking of these items difficult or near impossible.

The report starts with basic information about the site itself since it is a unique architectural monument from the Abbasid period. Thereafter, it will describe the modern use of the site by the DGAM, focusing on the storehouses. The archaeological expeditions that deposited their finds in the storehouses will be detailed and the report will provide a suggestion for a plan to construct a database. It will build on the results from the Focus Raqqa Project<sup>2</sup> lead by Leiden University in collaboration with the present author and the last museum director in Raqqa and Syrian students in the Netherlands. The report will then provide a general description of the contents of the storehouses based on the 2003 inventories, which were originally compiled in Arabic. Alongside this, an assessment of the damage to the archaeological knowledge is made. Finally, the report provides some instructions and suggestions to guide further research on the looted artefacts. The English and Arabic versions of the entire inventory lists are provided in appendices.

## 2. Heraqla

### 2.1 Etymology

Heraqla is one of the archaeological sites that has preserved its ancient name, and it is still known to the local community as Haragla. The name derives from the city of Heraqlia located in the modern-day Turkey. The Abbasid caliph Harun Al Rashid conquered this city at the beginning of the ninth century, and the site in Raqqa was given its name in commemoration of the victory.

### 2.2 Heraqla in the Islamic resources

After the death of the Byzantine empress Irene of Athens (reigned 780–802), who had paid an annual tribute to the Abbasid Caliphate, her successor, the emperor Nikephoros I (reigned 802–811) refused to continue with the payments. The Abbasid caliph Harun al Rashid (reigned 786–809) decided to invade the Byzantine territory and reestablish the former rules.<sup>3</sup> He invaded numerous cities, including Heraqla located in Ereğli (known as Heraclea Cybistra, Ηράκλεια Κυβίστρα, in Ancient Greek) in 806, and captured part of its population and brought the captives to his summer capital Raqqa. Among them was the daughter of the patriarch, according to Muslim historians.<sup>4</sup>

The Muslim scholar Al Tabari (839–923) wrote in his book *Tarikh al umam wa al mulouk* (History of the nations and kings, also known as History of the prophets and kings) that the caliph Harun Al Rashid conquered Heraqla and captured the population, including a girl who was engaged to the son of Nikephoros I. The latter sent gifts to Al Rashid and asked him to liberate the girl; the caliph accepted and did so.<sup>5</sup>

The traveler and geographer Yaqout al Hamaoui mentioned Heraqla in his famous book *Mu'jam al Buldan* (Dictionary of Countries) in the 13<sup>th</sup> century. He explained how the caliph Al Rashid conquered the city of Heraqla, captured the daughter of its patriarch, and then decided to build a castle or palace for her and name it Heraqla.<sup>6</sup>

## 2.3 Heraqla in European sources

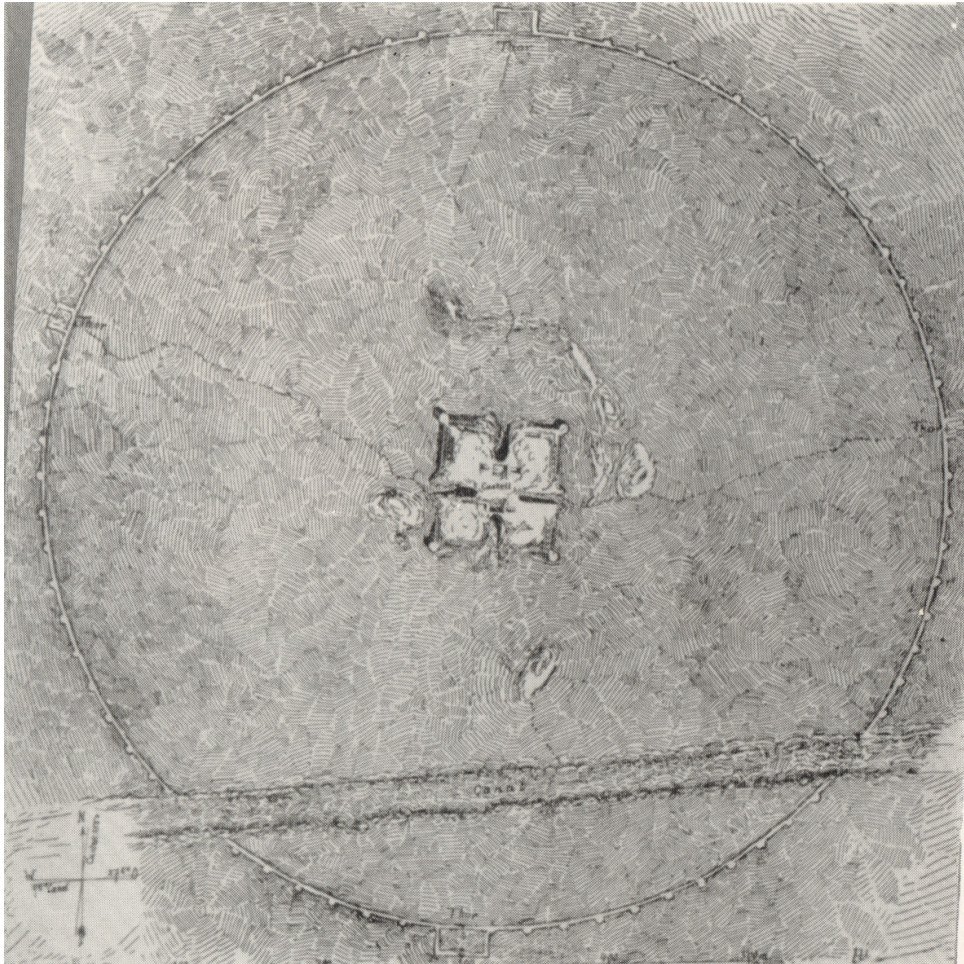


Fig.2: Plan of Heaqla (after Touyr, 1977-1978: 125).

Sachau<sup>7</sup> visited Heraqla in 1883 and dated it to the Greco-Roman period. Some years later, in 1912, Sarre and Herzfeld<sup>8</sup> produced a topographic study of the site (Fig. 2). Creswell<sup>9</sup> and Dussaud<sup>10</sup> visited Heraqla and agreed that the site belonged to the tradition of Abbasid architecture.<sup>11</sup>

## 2.4 Heraqla in local legends

Heraqla has become a symbol of "remoteness" for the modern, local population of Raqqa. When referring to something that is particularly far away, they say that "it is more far away than Haragla. The site is also associated with legends and histories about djinns and magic, and the older generation was reluctant to pass through it, especially at night.

## 2.5 Excavations at the site

The site was excavated in the 1970s–1980s and the results were published in Arabic at the time. The DGAM formed an expedition directed by Qasim Touyr and the first

season took place between October 5<sup>th</sup> and November 5<sup>th</sup>, 1976. In the following seasons, more experts from universities in New York, Beirut and France joined the excavations.<sup>12</sup>

The archaeologists started by surveying the site but could not find any shreds or small finds on the surface of the central building. Later they found fragments of ceramics and glassed pottery around it, inside the external circular wall. These finds were dated to the Abbasid period.<sup>13</sup>

## 2.6 Architecture

The site consists of the main building in the center and a circular wall surrounding it. The wall had square towers and four gates, one at each cardinal point (Fig. 2). The gates extended 18 m from the wall and had a width of 20 m.

The circular wall, the towers and the gates were built on top off a 1 m deep platform made of small stones (pebbles) bound by lime cement. The foundation for the central building, on the other hand, was 2 m deep and made of bricks and lime cement (mortar). With the exception for the central building, all architectural components of Heraqla were built as a primary stage since just one or two courses of stone were constructed. The plans for subsequent building activities were never realized.<sup>14</sup>

### 2.6.1 *The wall*

The circular wall had a diameter of 510 m. Its width was between 2.5 and 2.7 m, and it was composed by a core of small stones (pebbles) and lime of cement that was covered by an internal and external facing of carved plaster-stones (0.7 x 0.9 x 0.6 m). There were four gates, one at each cardinal point, as well as square towers distributed some 18-19 m from each other. Each tower measured 5.6 m in width and extended 2.5 m from the wall.<sup>15</sup>

### 2.6.2 *The northern gate*

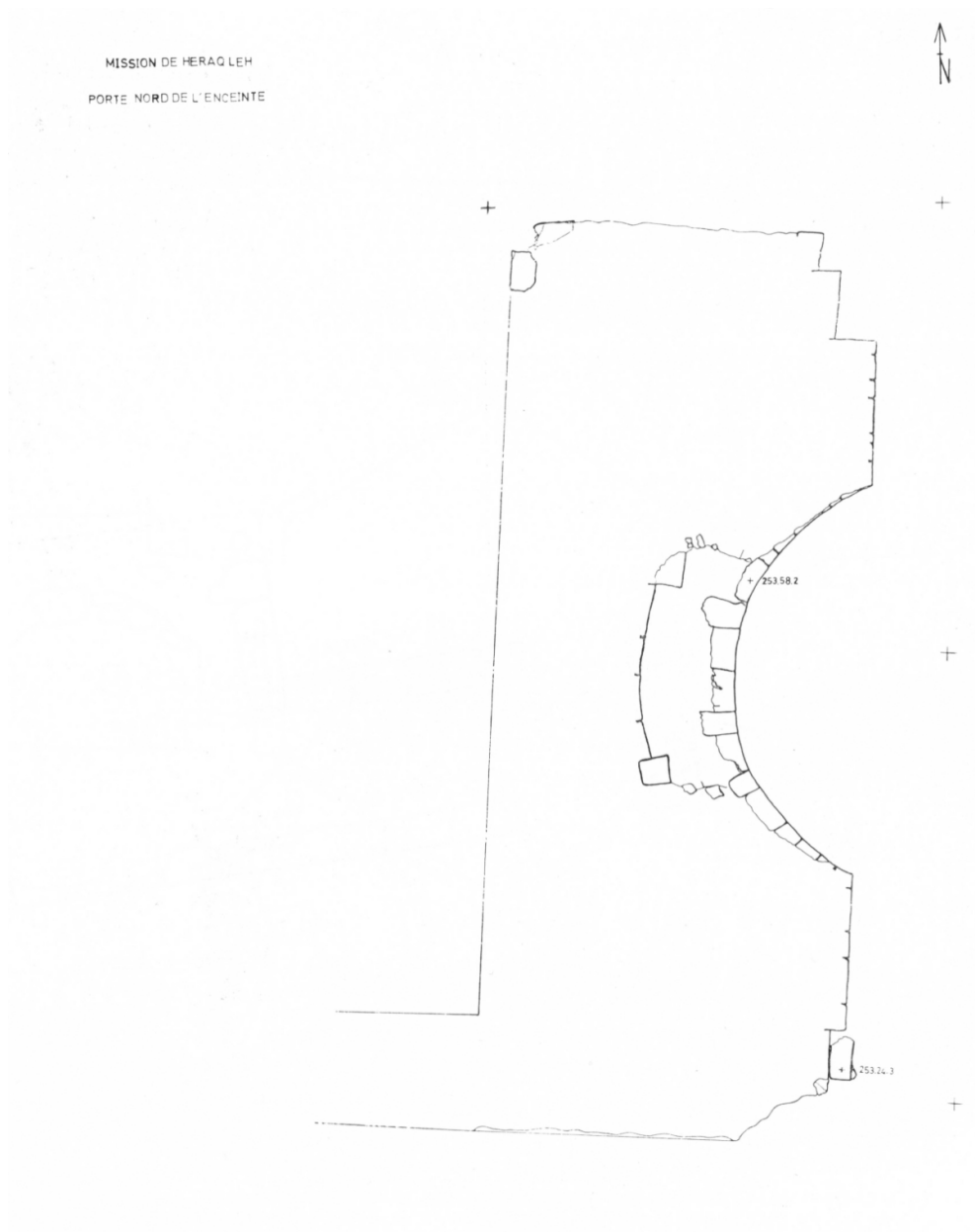


Fig.3: The western half of the northern gate (after Touyr, 1977-1978: 131 J).

The northern gate measured 20 x 8.10 m. Each half of the gate was rectangular in shape, and had a concave, semi-circular alcove of 8.10 m see fig. 3, showing the western half of the northern gate).

The external sides of the gate were built of carved plaster-stones, while the internal side was built of lime cement. On the top of the plaster stones were rectangular holes, possibly for liquid plumb that connected the stones to each other once dried. There is only one course of stones constructed. Behind the semicircular convex space was a rectangular space of 3.85m, perhaps used as a guard room.

All the four gates had quadrate form while the internal space takes in each one different geometric shape, the northern gate had a circular form.<sup>16</sup>

### 2.6.3 The western gate

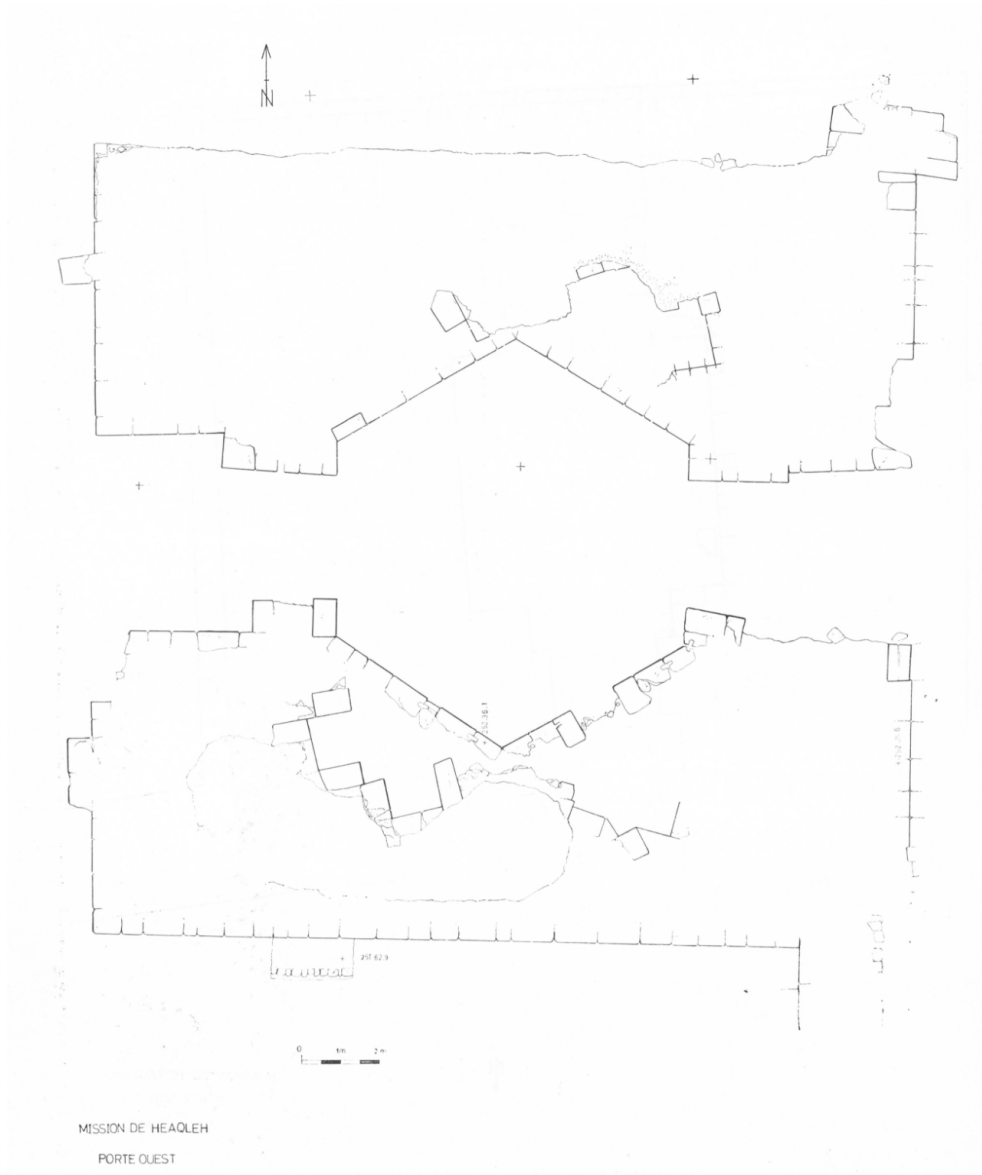


Fig. 4: The western gate (after Touyr, 1977-1978: 131 H).

The western gate was rectangular and measures 21.5 x 8 m (Fig. 4). It was expected to have the same rectangular form with a circular space inside as the northern gate, but instead the excavations demonstrated a hexagonal space inside.

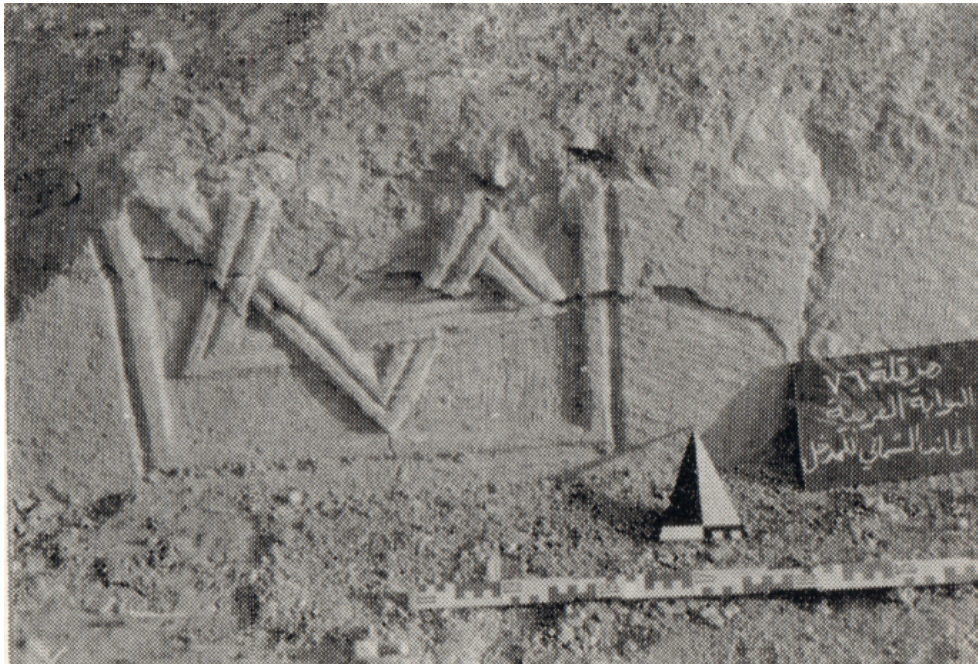


Fig. 5: Decoration of hexagonal star (after Touyr, 1977-1978: 127).

At this gate, excavations revealed some decorations made in high-relief technique. The first relief represented a hexagonal star formed by a double line curved in bas-relief. It was positioned inside a square mark measuring 0.5 m on each side. The star itself was destroyed and just the lower part of it had survived (Fig. 5). The second decoration was an octagonal star; it was also placed inside a 0.5 m wide square (Fig. 6).

Behind the hexagonal space, excavators discovered two spaces that had served as guard rooms. Again, one or two courses of stone were built.<sup>17</sup>

#### 2.6.4 The southern gate

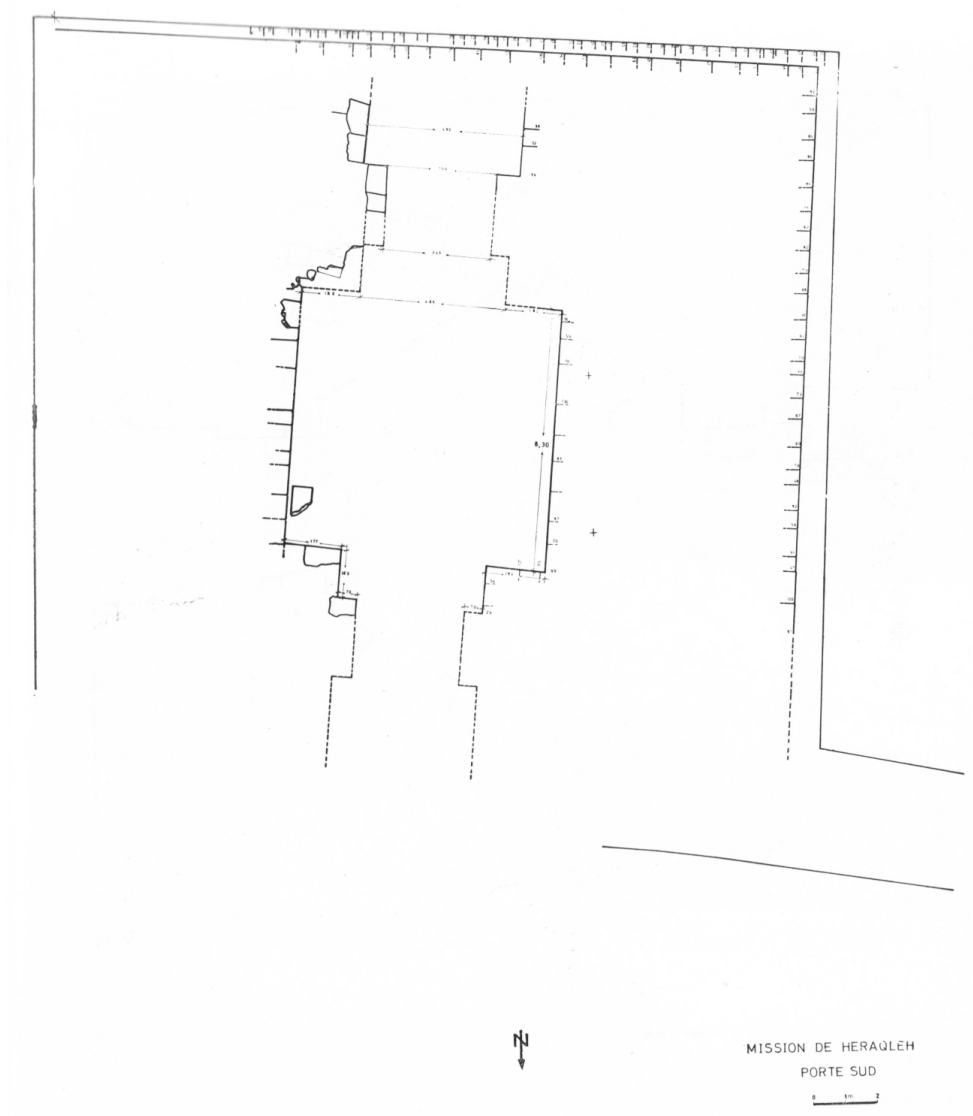


Fig. 7: The southern gate (after Touyr, 1977-1978: 131 W).

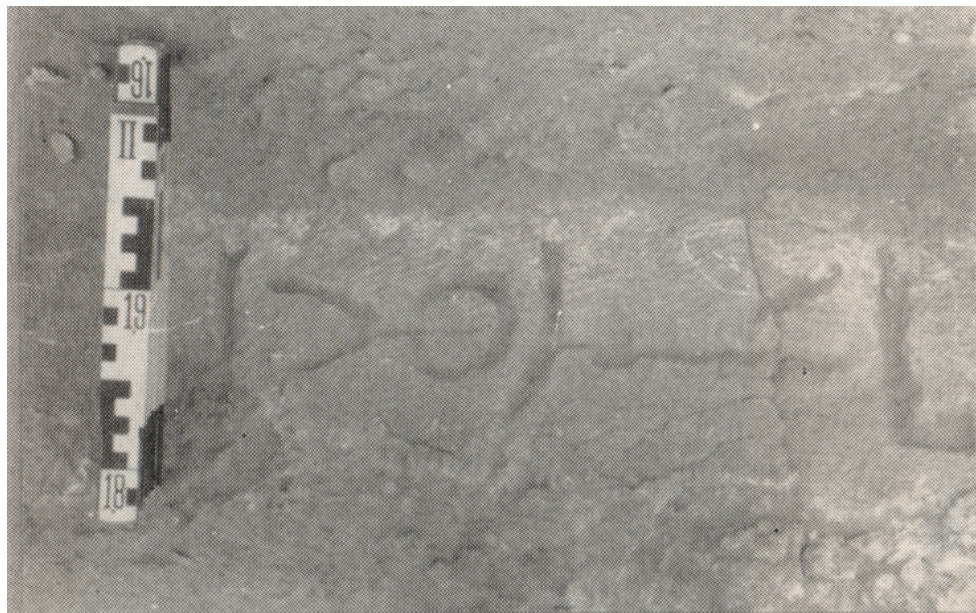


Fig. 8: Arabic inscriptions (after Touyr, 1977-1978: 129).

The internal space of the southern gate was square in shape (Fig. 7). The excavations revealed three stones with Arabic inscriptions. The stones were found upside down. One of these stones, measuring 0.36 x 0.1 m, contained the phrase: (*ma 'amal hatha*, meaning “what done this,” or “who did this” (Fig. 8) while the second and third stones contain the word (*Hadtheel*, possible the name of the architect (Fig. 9).

Possible canals for irrigation or drainage were also discovered in front of the southern gate inside the complex. Later the excavators realized that they were graves paved with bricks.<sup>18</sup>

### 2.6.5 The eastern gate

The eastern gate was revealed during the season of 1978. Its internal space had an octagonal shape.<sup>19</sup>

### 2.6.7 The central building

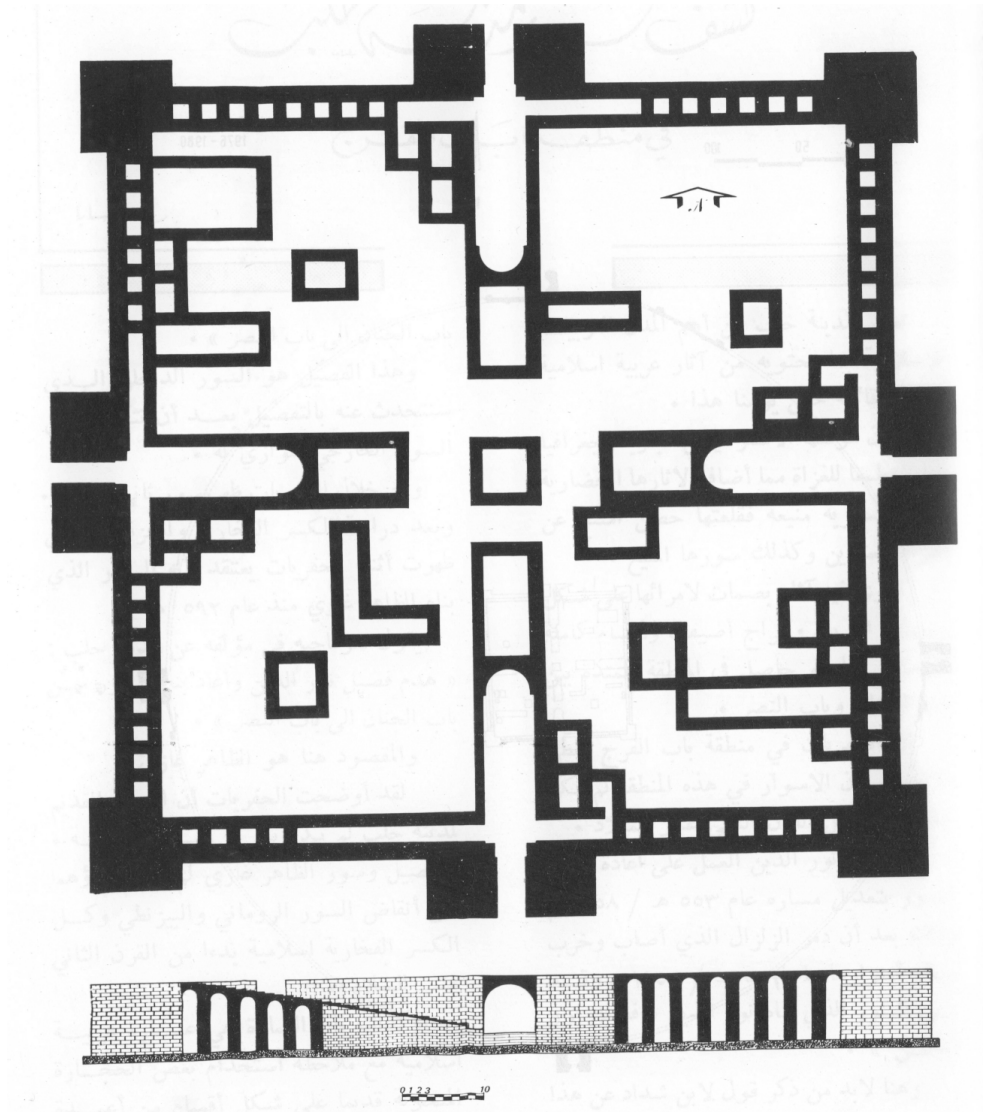


Fig. 10: Plan of the central building (after Touyr, 1983: 111).

The central building had a square form measuring 103 x 103 m and was located exactly in the center of the circular wall (Fig. 10). Each corner of the building had a tower measuring 11.4 x 11.4 x 3.5 m. Each one of the four sides of the central building had an *iwan*; a rectangular space walled on three sides, with one side entirely open. Each *iwan* measured 15.62 x 6.05 m, and terminated in a semicircular bend measuring 5.27 x 2.52 m. The entrance of each *iwan* had two lateral towers measuring 8.2 x 7.4 m. Beside the left tower was a stairway of 28 stairs that ascended in parallel to the building's side, towards the corner-tower. The first 15 stairs rested on an inclined structure of stones and lime cement, while the rest of the stairs rested on 6 arches. The pillars of the arches were 1.5 m and the space between each pillar measured 2 m. The height of the arches varied depending on the level of inclination. To the right side of each *iwan*, in front of the staircases, was an entrance, 2.5 m in

width, that opened to a 10.7 m long corridor. On its left side was a door measuring 1 m in width which opened to a 3.77 x 2.77 m rectangular room. Beyond this door, the excavation revealed eight arches similar to those for the staircases on the opposite side. These arches had the same height, but all arches were solid; they were closed by the external walls of the building's sides.

The entire building was constructed on a 2 m deep platform. The interior of the building was composed of different spaces separated by walls measuring 1.5 m in width. The layout consisted of a central square space of 5.2 m. Opposite each side of this square, rectangular spaces measuring 12 x 5 m that extended towards the cardinal points and gates. Within each quarter of the building formed by this layout were various square, rectangular, and L-shaped spaces. Excavations in three of these spaces demonstrated that they were filled to the top with sand and pebbles, and that they were vaulted (Fig. 11). The investigation also revealed that the rooms were without windows and doors. The floor of the first room was lowered to a depth of

4.5 m, and it was hard and made of lime cement. The walls of these rooms were made of stone while the vaults were made of bricks.<sup>20</sup>

All these features indicate that the *iwan*, the staircases and the guard rooms had a functional role, while the rest of components had an architectural function. This strange design of rooms without doors or windows, forming net of spaces filled with sand and pebbles, and the bricked vaults, indicate that the entire structure was well-planned and executed a special design desired by Al Rashid.

## 2.7 Heraqla's destination

The monument was never completed, and the dream of Harun Al Rashid never realized. Building material of lime cement similar to that used in the central building was found spread in an area surrounding the wall. This was likely the prepared material intended for the continued construction of the building's second floor as well as the circular wall and the gates.<sup>21</sup>

Al Rashid conquered Heraqla in 806 and stayed just three years in Raqqa after that before moving to Persia in 808/809 where he died. The subsequent internal conflicts of power between Harun's sons, Al Amin and Al Ma'mun, continued for five years, while Raqqa was neglected and the construction in Heraqla never resumed.

## 2.8 Heraqla's function

The function of the building is unlikely that described by Yaqt la Hamawi as a castle or residence for the girl captured at Heraqla in Turkey, since the caliph had already many palaces in Raqqa. It was more likely a monument to commemorate his victory over the Byzantine emperor in Heraqlia.

### 3. The DGAM and Heraqla

The DGAM emphasized the importance of the monumental building in Raqqa, and besides the historical importance, used it for two main activities: the production of bricks and as storehouses.

#### 3.1. Production of bricks

In 1974, the DGAM constructed four ovens to produce bricks similar to those used in the Abbasid architecture in Raqqa. These bricks were used for the restoration of the Abbasid city walls of Rafiqa/ Raqqa, the Ancient Mosque of Al Mansour, and the other sites such as the Castle of Ja'bar on the banks of the Lake Assad. The production was exclusively for the restoration of archaeological monuments, and it was not permitted to use them for other purposes or sell them to any other entity or person.

#### 3.2 Storehouses

In the 1960s, the DGAM built various rooms to hold the archaeological material found at excavations in the Raqqa province. The archaeological expeditions working in the province for more than sixteen years, usually deposited the small finds in these facilities in anticipation of further analysis and the construction of the new museum in Raqqa. The DGAM appointed three guards to secure a 24/7 protection of the site and the storehouses.

## 4. The inventory committee 2003

Before 2003, there was no inventory of the material stored at Heraqla. The storehouses were filled with boxes of archaeological material from numerous old excavations. Some of them were deposited hastily, especially those from emergency excavations connected to the Tabqa Dam project on the Euphrates Valley. The dam, which resulted in Lake Assad, was constructed between 1968 and 1973. UNESCO launched an international call to excavate the rich area and rescue the hundreds of archaeological sites that were threatened by the dam. After the excavations, the finds were registered only in the excavation register; they were never registered by the Department of Antiquities and Museums of Raqqa. The most important finds were then delivered to the Museum in Raqqa, while the rest were stored in Heraqla. Likewise, other excavators deposited their finds in Heraqla because of the limited space in the museum.

After being appointed as a Director of the National Museum of Raqqa, the author asked the DGAM for permission to make a general inventory of all finds at Heraqla in the summer 2003. This was when the preliminary lists of the storehouses' content were prepared. The work involved Mr. Nawras Mohammed, who worked at the museum, as well as a student from the German expedition at Tell Chuera. Unfortunately, I cannot remember her name.

During the process we identified some important finds which were immediately moved to the museum and integrated in the general register, such as the finds made of gold. Other relevant objects were transferred and exhibited in the museum or the museum's garden. For example, large fragments of basalt statutes containing cuneiform inscriptions from the Assyrian period were exhibited in the garden until the museum was also looted. We identified the objects in need of restoration and emergency conservation and prepared them to be sent to the laboratories of the DGAM in Damascus. However, due to the events that followed they were never sent.

## 4.1 International and local expeditions that deposited their finds at Heraqla

The archaeological expeditions that deposited their finds in Heraqla should be involved in the recovery research. All the excavators and universities that participated in the archaeological labor, including myself, welcome any collaboration and further research on the collections at Heraqla. These expeditions include:

- The expeditions at **Tell Fray**: the site was excavated in 1972–1973 by the Syrian-Italian joint expedition directed by Adnan Bounni from Syria and Paolo Matthiae from Italy, as response to the international call launched by the UNESCO to save the area that would be flooded by the construction of Tabqa Dam.
- The German expeditions at **Tell Chuera**: it was excavated by Freie Universität Berlin under the direction of Anton Moortgat and Ursula Moortgat in 1958–1976, then by the University of Halle under the direction of Winfried Orthmann until 1998, and finally by the Goethe-Universität Frankfurt under the direction of Jan-Waalke Meyer in 1998 until the civil war in Syria 2011.
- The German expeditions at **Halawa**: the site of Hawiget Halawa was excavated first in 1972 by the DGAM and Adnan Bounni after finding mosaics from the 5<sup>th</sup> century. In 1974, the German expedition directed by Winfried Orthmann excavated the 3<sup>rd</sup> millennium B.C.E settlement and graves.
- The German expeditions at **Tell Munbaqa**: the Technische Universität of Hamburg and Martin-Luther Universität, Halle-Wittenberg, Germany excavated under the direction of Dittmar Machule until the civil war in Syria 2011.
- The Dutch expeditions at **Tell Hammam et Turkman**: excavated by Leiden University and directed by Diedreik J.W Meijer between 1981–2001.
- The Dutch expeditions at **Tell Sabi Abyad**: excavated by Leiden University and the Netherlands National Museum of Antiquities (Rijksmuseum van Oudheden) and directed by Peter M. M. G. Akkermans since 1986 until the civil war in Syria 2011.
- The North American expedition at **Tell es- Sweyhat**: it was excavated in 1973–1975 by the Ashmolean Museum of Oxford University under the direction of Thomas Holland, as part of the salvage project connected to the construction of Tabqa Dam. Holland's excavations continued with the Oriental Institute of Chicago and the University of Pennsylvania Museum in 1989, together with Richard L. Zettler, until 1991. Zettler excavated until

2007 and then Michael D. Danti from Boston University continued the excavations until 2011.

- The Excavation at **Tell el-‘Abd**: it was excavated 1971-1972, first by a Syrian expedition directed by Adnan Bounni from the DGAM. Then the joint expedition of the DGAM and the Universität Tuebingen continued the excavations under the direction of Uwe Finbeiner between 1992 and 1994.
- The excavations at **Tell Sheikh Hassan** started in 1963 by Abdul Kader Rihaoui and continued in 1964 by Maurits. N. van Loon and in 1976 by Jacques Cauvin. Winfried Orthmann excavated the site in 1981 and between 1984 and 1997 the University of Saarbruecken directed by Johannes Boese advanced the excavation.
- The German expedition at **Tell Bi’a** carried out 12 excavation seasons between 1980 and 1995. These excavations were directed by Eva Strommenger and the team from the Deutschen Orient-Gesellschaft.
- The Japanese expedition at **Tell Rumeilah** (known also as Tell Ali al-Hajj) started first in 1974 by the Ancient Orient Museum in Tokyo, directed by Keiko Ishida. Its aim was to uncover the sites threatened by modern dam construction.
- The national expeditions of the DGAM, such as the excavations at the site of **Tell ’nab as-Safina** in 1971 and 1972, directed by Adnan Bounni.
- And finally, objects that were confiscated by Syrian authorities; some of them were from Syrian sites and others were ready to be restituted to their countries of origin.

## 4.2 The looting of Heraqla

In Syria, the DGAM managed the cultural heritage satisfyingly until the outbreak of the civil war in March of 2011. The province of Raqqa was a completely quiet and safe place during the first two years of the war. However, in 2013 the government lost control and numerous heritage sites were damaged and looted.<sup>22</sup> The DGAM started preventive measures after the fall of Raqqa; the museum staff built defensive walls of bricks and cement at the storehouse’s doors, and the Department of Raqqa moved part the finds to the house of one of the guards in the village of Heraqla, to be transferred to Damascus at a later point, but these measures came too late. On November 3, 2013, a group of 100 armed individuals attacked the

site and looted all of the archaeological finds from the storehouses and the guard's home. Only the large mosaics were left.<sup>23</sup>

### 4.3 General remarks on the inventory

We do not have enough information or images of the finds since the idea of the first inventory was to create a general overview, rather than a complete database of the entire collection. The lists were prepared in Arabic and are provided here in an English version as well.

The total number of the objects is 6429. We are able to classify them in the following categories: pottery, metal, stone, beads, glass, bone, and not specified (i.e. the material is not specified in the lists) (CHART. 1).

The pottery forms the largest category of finds in the storehouses; in total 3949 objects, which vary between vessels, clay figurines, liver models, spindle whorls, weights, cylinder seals, seal impressions and chariots (CHART. 2).

The metal category contains 635 objects and includes bronze, iron, gold, and lead. They come in the form of pins, daggers, rings, bracelets, and coins (CHART. 3).

The finds of stone consist of 333 objects made from stone, flint, obsidian and alabaster, and include arrowheads, mortars, scrapers and statuettes (CHART. 4).

The lists consisted of 94 boxes numbered from 1 to 53. Some boxes received numbers and letters for example Box 10- 10A- 10B-10C, and we decided to keep the numeration in order to facilitate consultation with the original lists in Arabic if needed.

The number of objects in each box varied, some boxes contained just one object while others contained hundreds.

Many objects were found under the same number in the lists. In these cases, the inventory work counted the number of items and registered the excavation number of one of these objects. For example: Box 28, Tell Chuera contains 193 objects, one of them holds the number GHA90: J68.

Various objects were found in sacks containing fragments of pottery, bronze, etc. The number of the objects varied between a few and hundreds, but they had just one inventory number.

In some boxes, copies of the excavation records (list of archaeological finds discovered) were attached. They consisted of 3 copied pages; one white, one blue, and one red. The white copy was sent to the DGAM, the red to the Department of excavation in the governorate (Raqqqa in this case), and the blue was sent to the expedition that excavated the site. Obtaining the copies held by the international universities will be of great value in the future and will allow the reconstruction of more details concerning each registered find.

The inventory did not include the site of Tell Sabi Abyad since the Dutch expedition had adequately organized its storehouse at Heraqla. Therefore, it was not necessary redo the work, except of few items that appeared belonging to an older excavation.

Box 25 is titled *Tell Sheikh Hamad 1986-1988-1990-1996*; however, it read *Tell Sheikh Hassan*.

The relevance of the present report comes from the fact that it is the only document on the content of the storehouses at Heraqla. It does not offer the complete information, nor is the annexed lists *per se* sufficient for tracing the looted objects. But they are still the fundamental, initial stage of more comprehensive research in order to build a complete database for the recovery of the lost finds.

## 4.4 Recommendations and concluding remarks

In order to create a record of Heraqlas finds, the work should rely on this document to gather more information. Contacts with excavators and universities that ran the excavations are essential, and they are all open to collaborate and facilitate access to the necessary data. The work should start with reviewing the excavation register and compare these with the excavation numbers marked on the objects listed in the annexed lists. This way, more details about the objects, possible drawings and images as well as the archaeological contexts may be reconstructed. It is a tremendous mission that needs time, expertise, dedication, and funding for a group of researchers and students to be able to reconstruct the register. Once completed, as we did during our work in the project Focus Raqqqa, the database should be submitted to the DGAM to INTERPOL, who in turn can share it with the international museums, police, customs and researchers to thwart any illicit trafficking of these objects on the black market.

The mission will be tremendous and needs international collaboration to accomplish it. We hope the present report will encourage the heritage community to act and that it will be used as a firsthand source for research that will fill our gap of knowledge, identify the looted items and facilitate their recovery.

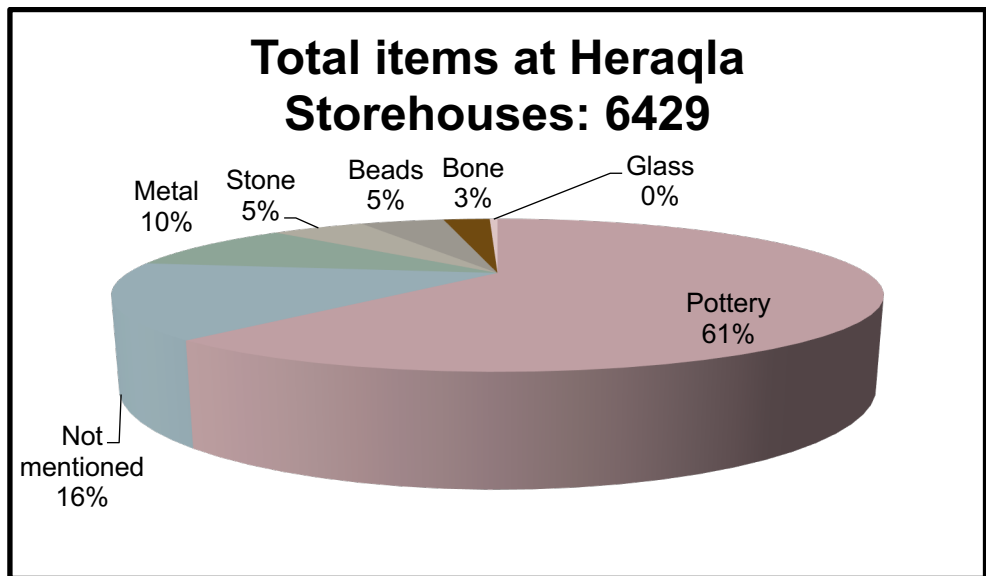


Chart 1. Total archaeological items at the Heraqla Storehouses classified by material.

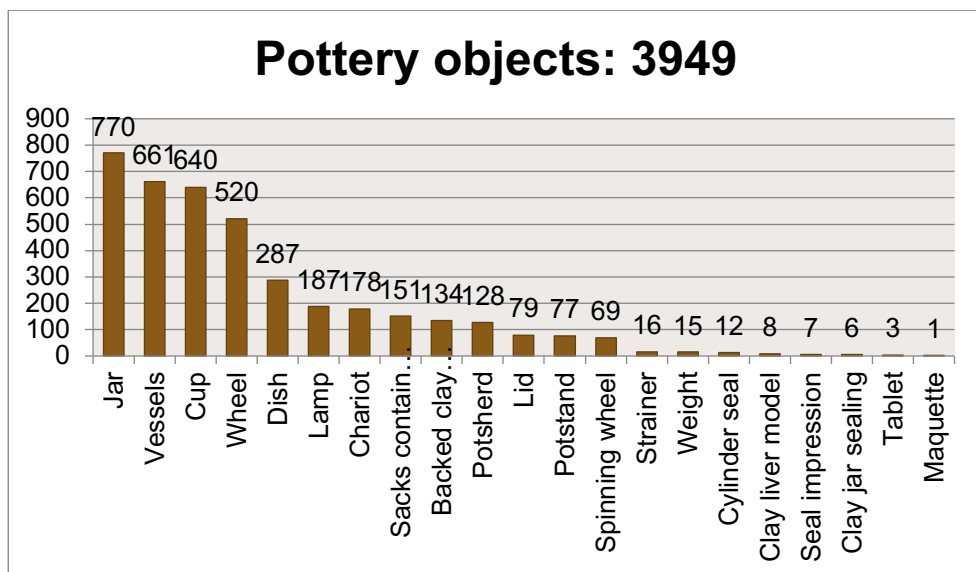


Chart 2. Pottery objects at the Heraqla Storehouses.

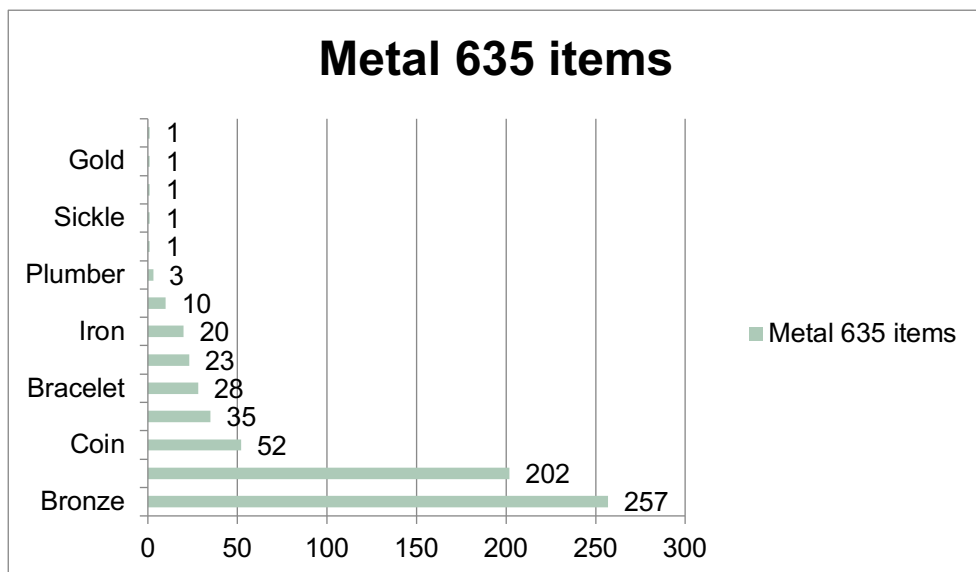


Chart 3. Metal objects at the Heraqla Storehouses.

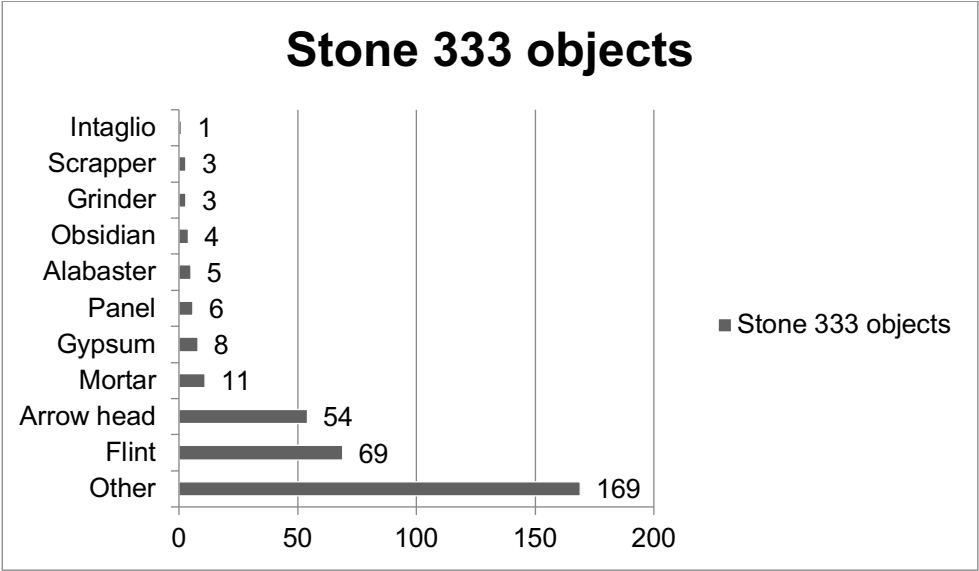


Chart 4. Stone objects.
